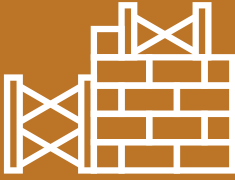

VOCATIONAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Grade 2 or above including Mathematics and English.

Description

This qualification consists of 70% practical work and 30% theory work. Your practical work takes place in our purpose-built workshops where you work your way towards units by way of theory and practical tests that are assessed by qualified assessors. Theory sessions underpin the practical work by covering trade technology and associated subjects.

Over the year, you will achieve the qualification by attending college four days per week (full-time only).

What you learn:

The course covers all the elements of Brickwork and site work. Other related subjects include:

- Bonding
- Brick manufacture
- Concrete
- Drainage
- Health and safety
- Mortar and mixing
- Setting out
- Tools and equipment

Units include:

- Health & Safety in construction trades
- Working and communicating effectively in construction trades
- Build a brick wall
- Build a block wall
- Build a cavity wall

How you will be assessed:

Your certificate will be assessed by practical end tests and completion of a workbook.
