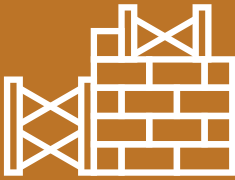

2 GCSEs at grade 2 or above including Mathematics and English.

Description

This course involves three days of study a week. The course will give learners the opportunity to engage in learning which will provide opportunities to develop a range of skills and techniques, personal skills and attributes essential for successful performance in working life, whilst developing their knowledge and awareness of Carpentry and Joinery.

What you learn:

Units include:

- Maintain and use carpentry and joinery hand tools.
- Prepare and use carpentry and joinery portable power tools.
- Produce woodworking joints.
- Health safety and welfare in construction.
- Principles of building construction information and communication.

How you will be assessed:

Your diploma will be assessed by practical end tests and online end of unit tests.

What next:

Successful completion of this Level 1 Diploma study programme can lead to a place on a whole range of the Colleges Level 2 Diploma study programmes.

You will be asked to choose at Level 2 from the two options of Site Carpentry or Bench Joinery and you will need to progress into employment if you are to progress to Level 3.

Bench Joinery is manufacturing timber products such as windows, doors and stairways. Site Carpentry involves working out in the site environments on projects such as roofing or hanging doors, fitting skirting etc.
