Description

This course covers all the elements of Plastering from using handtools and equipment from mixing plasters and applying plaster and render finishes. Other related subjects include: Material Manufacture, Mixing Materials, Tools and Equipment, Setting Out and Health and Safety.

Alongside the practical tasks, you will learn about materials and equipment, types of plaster and all basic plastering techniques.

You will work in a purpose built workshop that is designed to stretch and challenge all learner's skills and knowledge during training for synoptic end assessments using the very best, up to date resources that the industry has to offer. Theory classes are held in modern classrooms with excellent resources and taught by highly experienced and knowledgeable staff.

Over the year, you will achieve the qualifications by attending college four days per week. (Full time only)

What you learn:

This course covers all elements of painting and decorating and site work. Other related subjects include:

- Health & Safety
- Mixing of plasters
- Identification of tools and equipment
- Knowledge of building materials

Units include:

- Introduction to health and safety in construction
- Preparing background surfaces and applying finishing coats
- Mixing materials and applying floating coats
- Producing components from moulds

How you will be assessed:

Your certificate will be assessed by practical end tests and completion of a workbook.

Successful completion of this Level 1 certificate will lead to the Level 2 Diploma in Plastering or ideally in to an apprenticeship.
