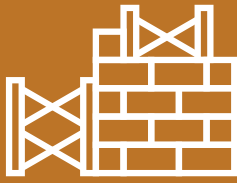

Description

This course covers all the elements of Plastering from using handtools and equipment to apply plaster finishes to internal and external backgrounds, screeding, rendering and producing decorative mouldings.

You will work in a purpose built workshop that is designed to stretch and challenge all learner's skills and knowledge during training for synoptic end assessments using the very best, up to date resources that the industry has to offer. Theory classes are held in modern classrooms with excellent resources and taught by highly experienced and knowledgeable staff.

Over the year, you will achieve the qualifications by attending college four days per week. (Full time only)

What you learn:

This course covers all elements of painting and decorating and site work. Other related subjects include:

- Health & Safety
- Producing internal and external finishes
- Communication in construction
- Mixing of various plasters and renders

Units include:

- Health, safety & welfare in construction
- Principles of building construction, information and communication
- Apply plastering materials to interiors
- Fix dry lining and plasterboards to interiors
- Laying sand and cement screeds
- Apply plastering materials to external backgrounds

How you will be assessed:

Your diploma will be assessed by practical end tests and online end of unit tests.
