



NEET and Moving On Project.

The college supports young people who are at risk of becoming NEET (not in employment, education or training).

The project offers these pupils the opportunity to learn new skills, gain formal qualifications and employability skills and become 'work ready'. This then progresses the pupils to further training, re-engagement with education, an Apprenticeship or even employment.

The main channels that identify and direct young people to the project are:

- Current pupils identified by Nelson and Colne College . and Accrington and Rossendale staff
- Referrals from external agencies already engaged with young people who are NEET
- Year 11 pupils via teacher referrals working with 'at risk' sliqua

Who is eligible for the NEET/Moving On project?

Moving On supports young people in Lancashire aged between 15 – 18 years old who are at risk of becoming NEET. This includes those aged 16 to 18 who are already NEET and young people who have learning difficulties and/or disabilities (LDD) and who have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP). Moving On re-engages young people and provides personalised packages of support to tackle attendance, attainment, performance and behavioural issues.

- Self/parental referrals via walk ins at the Apprenticeship and Training Centre on Scotland Road
- As part of a student pathway into achieving their long term goal of becoming an Apprentice or progressing into Higher Education
