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T Levels.

The College has been working in collaboration with employers and sector leaders to introduce new trailblazing qualifications for industry.

What are T Levels?

T Levels are ground breaking two-year advanced qualifications that offer students a mixture of classroom-based learning and 'on-the-job' experience. They are designed in collaboration with employers, are the equivalent to three A Levels, and include an exciting 45 day industry placement in your chosen sector.

T Levels are designed to give students the knowledge, skills and experience companies are looking for, helping you to step straight into your chosen career, higher level Apprenticeships or onto a degree. T Levels are equivalent to three A Levels.

What will I study?

As part of your classroom learning you will study challenging subject relevant topics to give you the core knowledge and skills needed to work in the sector, as well as enhance your broader skills in English and Maths. You will be assessed through a range of external exams, assessments and coursework.

What next?

T Levels will provide the knowledge and experience you need to enter skilled employment in a particular occupation or continue with further study.

Students achieving this qualification will have an advantage when applying for jobs within their chosen industry or when progressing into further study.

Additional Learning Support (ALS Team).

We have a dedicated team of professionals who support students with any disability or learning support needs.

Our team is committed to ensuring that every student has the support and resources to achieve their full potential. Whether you have a special educational need or a disability, the ALS team will be there for you every step of the way, providing tailored support to help you get the most out of learning. Service and facilities include:

The ALS Study Zone

The ALS Study Zone is a multi-functional resource that students can access while at College. It can provides learners with a quiet place to study within a more focused environment. The ALS Study Zone is staffed by a member of the Additional Learning Support Team who will be able to arrange a wide range of services including 1:1 or group support, Assignment guidance and exam revision techniques and Personal development, mentoring and coaching for success and Informal support on a daily basis

Disability Support

If learners have a physical disability, visual impairment or hearing impairment, we do our best to provide them with all the support, equipment, access and learning resources they might need throughout their time at College. This support is confidential and information provided will only be shared with the appropriate professionals to meet their individual needs.

Learning Support

If students have a learning difficulty or disability, for example, Dyslexia, Dyspraxia or Asperger Syndrome, we have specialist teams of staff who will be able to support them throughout their time at College. Support can range from one-to-one support inside and outside of the classroom, workshops or just arranging extra time in examinations. If they have learning support needs, please ensure they mention this on their application to College, or during their interview.

Education Health and Care Plan

If any of your learners have an Education Health and Care Plan, and need more comprehensive support, we can work with them and your school, and the Local Authority to ensure they get the best possible support when they come to College. Arrangements can be made for transition visits to help with the move from school to College, and we are happy to come out to school to see what works best for you.




