DURATION 2 YEARS*

You will need to have achieved at least five GCSE passes at Grade 5 or above, including Maths and/or English to enrol, plus any specific entry requirements for individual courses

LEVEL 2

DURATION

1TO 2 YEARS

A Level 2 qualification is equivalent to GCSE Grades 4-9 and you will be expected to have achieved at least four GCSEs at Grade 4 or above, including Maths and/or English, to enrol on to one of these programmes. Successful completion of this course will pave the way for you to further your studies at Level 3.

LEVEL 1

DURATION 1 YEAR

You will need to have gained at least two GCSEs at grade 3 or above, including Maths and English, to study a Level 1 programme. These will build on your existing skills and upon successful completion, allow you to progress to a Level 2 course.

*Most courses are for two years, however some Level 3 courses are delivered in one year.

MARKETING EXECUTIVE

Marketing Executives play a pivotal role in creating and promoting diverse marketing campaigns, spanning product, service, or event promotions. Responsibilities encompass market research, email marketing, copywriting, and client communication. They may also handle PR, event organisation, and social media management, adapting tasks based on the organisation's size and needs.

FINANCIAL ADVISER

Financial Advisers offer expert guidance on money management, combining financial expertise with strong interpersonal skills. They research financial products, advise clients, and may specialise in areas like pensions, mortgages, or investments. Two types of advisers exist: independent (providing unbiased advice) and restricted (focusing on limited products). Key responsibilities include client meetings, financial analysis, product research, and compliance with industry rules. Keeping updated on financial products and legislation is crucial.

PROJECT MANAGER

Project Managers oversee projects from start to finish, managing resources, budgets, and teams to achieve goals. They set deadlines, delegate tasks, and report progress to senior managers. Specialisations can include construction, engineering, IT, or marketing. Responsibilities involve project initiation, planning, team leadership, monitoring, risk management, and reporting, with adherence to established project management processes and methodologies.

HOW DO I GET THERE?

A marketing career welcomes graduates from various backgrounds, with degrees or HNDs in subjects like advertising, business. communications, IT, marketing, or psychology being advantageous. Employers value personal qualities and experience, as well as familiarity with digital media. Entry can start as a Marketing Assistant, with apprenticeships and professional qualifications like CIM offerings available. Postgraduate qualifications are beneficial but not mandatory.

HOW DO I GET THERE?

Financial advice careers are accessible to graduates from various disciplines, with accountancy, business management, and finance degrees being advantageous. Entry is possible without a degree, with employers valuing personal qualities and customer service, sales, or financial services skills. Paraplanning offers an entry point,

and postgraduate qualifications are not obligatory. Kev skills include communication, research. negotiation, and discretion. Work experience in sales, advisory, or customer service roles is beneficial, along with shadowing or talking to financial advisers for insights into the field.

HOW DO I GET THERE?

Project management welcomes graduates from various disciplines, but business or project management degrees offer practical insights. Postgraduate study can enhance understanding but isn't mandatory. Accredited degrees by the Association for Project Management (APM) are recommended. Entry may begin in junior roles, and progression relies on experience.

In technical sectors like IT and engineering, subject knowledge is vital for transitioning into project management. Essential skills include organisation, communication, budget management, and technical expertise. Gaining experience in resource and team management through internships or extracurricular activities is valuable. Joining professional bodies like APM or PMI can aid networking and skill development.

Applications for courses starting in September 2024 open in September 2023. We accept applications throughout the year, however we encourage you to apply early so you can be part of our applicant journey.
